## REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY SERVICE CONNECTION



- 1. District installs temporary hydrant meter and opens the hydrant.
- 2. Do NOT operate hydrant or valves on hydrant (District Personnel ONLY).
- 3. Use temporary hydrant meter valve only to control flow (turn on or off).
- **4.** Do **NOT** remove or relocate temporary hydrant meters.
- **5.** Do NOT make a connection to the hydrant without a temporary hydrant meter.
- **6.** Do **NOT** make any hard plumb connection(s) to the hydrant and/or the temporary hydrant meter.
- 7. Unauthorized use of hydrant (Section 1806). (Unauthorized use of water or tampering with any fire hydrant is a misdemeanor punishable by law).
- **8.** Any damage to a hydrant or a temporary hydrant meter due to improper operation, tampering or unauthorized use will result in repair or replacement costs that shall be borne by the applicant or user.
- 9. Duration of Service and Rates Temporary service connections shall be disconnected and terminated within 60 days of installation unless an extension has been granted in writing by the Improvement District prior to the end of the 60 day period (Section 1802). <u>Each 60 day period requires completion of a new "Request for Temporary Service Connection" form and payment of the \$150.00 service charge to begin a new 60 day timeframe.</u>
- **10.** Customer must provide written request to discontinue temporary service connection and provide at least 24 hour prior notice (Monday Friday).

The undersigned acknowledges that they are familiar with the Rules and Regulations of the Santa Ynez River Water Conservation District, Improvement District No.1 and agrees to abide by said Rules and Regulations at all times as they now exist or may hereafter be amended.
